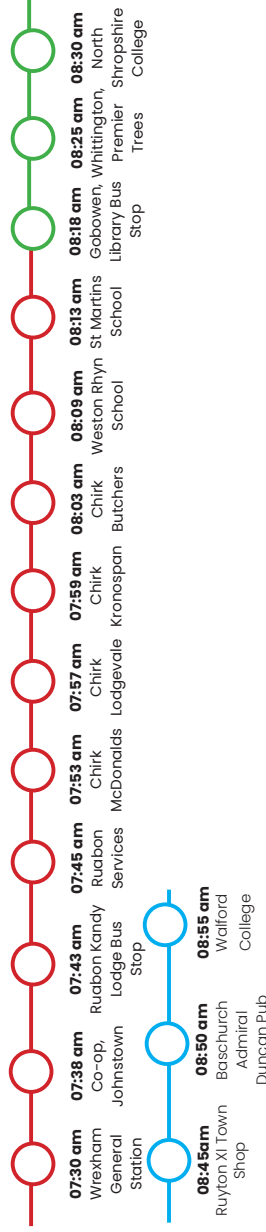


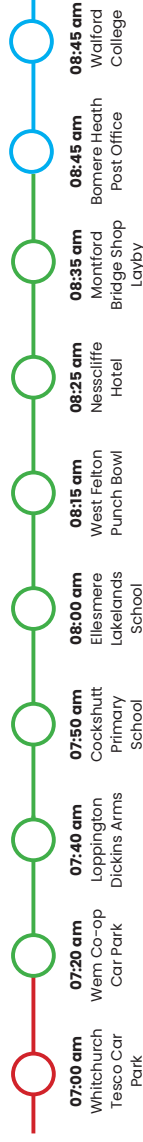

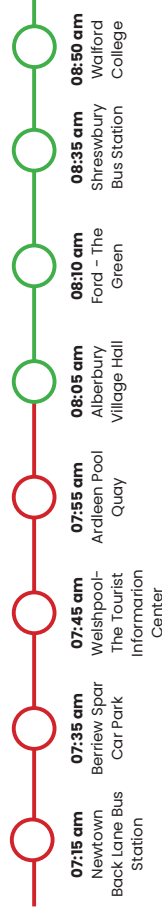
Route NSC 4 Owens 26 Seater



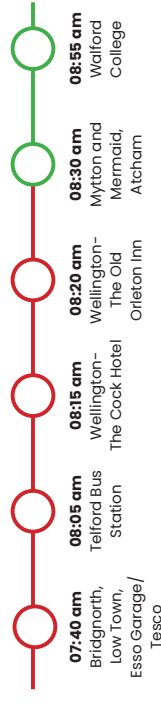
ROUTE NSC 7 (BA1043) NSC Minibus

All routes will depart from Walford campus at 4:30pm

Accessing local education and training can often be a challenge for some of our young people due to the high cost of travel. Walford College offers subsidised travel on all routes for the 24/25 academic year. Travel remains free on all routes where students are eligible for a travel bursary with a household income of £30,000 or under. Alternatively, to spread the cost, payment plans and termly passes are available. To apply for a college bus pass please fill out the application form on the back and return it to Student Services. Application packs are available online or from Student Services.

A zoning system for passes is as follows:

Blue Zone

Within 4 miles of Walford College to be attended - £472.50 per academic year

Green Zone

Within 5-15 miles of Walford College to be attended - £577.50 per academic year

Red Zone

Over 15 miles from Walford College to be attended - £682.50 per academic year
